

2021 MILDRED MILLIGAN SCHOLARSHIP COMPETITION

Dear Houston Harpists:

The Greater Houston Chapter of the American Harp Society (www.houstonharpists.com) is pleased to announce the 2021 Mildred Milligan Scholarship Competition for members of the GHC. The competition will take place on Sunday, April 25th, 1:00 pm - 8:00 pm at St. Luke's Presbyterian Church.

The main goals of this competition are educational: encouraging student growth and development by challenging harpists to prepare for an adjudicated performance and building a sense of community for Houston area harpists.

All contestants, as well as their teachers, must be members of the Greater Houston Chapter of the American Harp Society. Membership application is included on the last page of the competition application.

- Students will perform before a panel of judges (without a screen). Parents, family members, teachers, and friends are encouraged to listen during students' performance.
- The judges' decisions are final.
- Winners in each category will perform for the Milligan Competition Winners' Recital (Date TBD).
- First Place Winners in all categories will receive a cash prize. Second and Third place winners will be chosen for all categories and will receive a gift certificate to a harp retailer.
- In addition to a cash prize, the First Place Winner of the Division VI (college level) will receive a recital performance opportunity as part of the GHC's 2021/2022 season. Repertoire may include chamber music as well as solo.
- Arrival and audition time will be sent via email to all registered contestants.

To participate in the competition students must prepare from memory both a required piece, and a “free choice” piece. Division VI prepares two free choice pieces. The time limit of the free choice piece varies by division. Contestants will be judged by professional harpists. Judges will award scores in the following areas:

- Accuracy of Notes/Rhythm
- Dynamics/Phrasing
- Memory
- Tempo
- Overall Artistic Performance

It is important for competitors to select a “free choice” piece that can be performed accurately, by memory, and with the correct dynamics, phrasing, and tempo. Overall, judges will be looking for the most polished performances.

We hope that you and your students will take advantage of this exciting opportunity! Please note that the registration deadline is **March 15th**. If you have any questions or would like to volunteer to help with this event, please contact me via email at njhoffmeyer@gmail.com.

MUSIC REQUIREMENTS

Sunday, April 25th, 2021

All pieces must be played from memory

DIVISION I (grades 1-3)

1. **Honeybee** from **Suzuki Harp School Vol. 1** by M.K. Waddington
2. Free Choice – 2 minute time limit

DIVISION II (grades 4-5)

1. **Waterfall** from **Solos for Sonja** by Ruth K. Inglefield
2. Free Choice – 4 minute time limit

DIVISION III (grades 6-7)

1. **A Magyar Lament** from **The Magic Road** by Nancy Gustavson
2. Free Choice – 5 minute time limit

DIVISION IV (grades 8-9)

1. **Two Guitars** from **Graded Recital Pieces Vol. 4** by Susann McDonald and Linda Wood (please omit pedal instructions in mm. 22-24).
2. Free Choice – 7 minute time limit

DIVISION V (grades 10-12)

1. **“Waltz of the Flowers” Cadenza** from **Nutcracker Suite** by Tchaikovsky (any edition, please include the opening arpeggios).
2. Free Choice – 7 minute time limit

DIVISION VI (College: up through age 24)

1. Free Choice – 8 minute time limit (complete work or movement)
2. Free Choice – 8 minute time limit (contrasting work or movement)

FIRST PLACE PRIZES: Division I-\$50
Division II-\$75
Division III-\$150
Division IV- \$200
Division V-\$250
Division VI-\$400 and GHC 2021/2022 recital performance

*All Second and Third Place winners will receive a gift certificate. All competitors receive a certificate of participation.

RULES:

- The contestant as well as his/her teacher must both be current members of the Greater Houston Chapter of the American Harp Society (AHS). Membership to the national AHS is not required.
- Music must be memorized. Repeats are optional, unless otherwise stated.
- You must present two copies and the original of your free choice piece at the competition.
- Both pieces must have each measure numbered.
- If you have won first place in a category, you are not eligible to compete in that division again. However, you would be eligible to compete in a more advanced division.
- You are welcome to compete in a more advanced division than your actual grade level, but not a less advanced division.
- Contestants may be disqualified if there is any disregard to rules.
- A category deemed too large may be split into two groups—the schedule will reflect this.
- All prize winners will have the opportunity to play for the final spring meeting of the Greater Houston Chapter.

DAY OF THE COMPETITION:

- Students can provide their own instruments. A pedal harp and a lever harp will be available for use if requested. Assistance in moving harps will be available.
- Please dress professionally, and bring a sweater/jacket—the building can be chilly.
- Contestants will NOT perform behind a screen.
- Contestants will be given their specific performance time after registration has closed. Please plan your arrival to allow yourself plenty of time to be tuned, warmed up, and ready to play.
- No judge will serve in a division in which they have a student.
- The decisions of the judges are final.
- Contestants will be escorted to warm-up rooms following check in. Contestants will be notified in advance when they are next to perform and then escorted into the recital hall for their performances.
- Please do not talk in the hallways. Behavior must be respectful and courteous. As in any competition, noises are distracting and inconsiderate.
- All contestants as well as family, friends, and teachers are welcome to observe performances.
- Winners will be announced via email the following day.
- All contestants will receive a certificate and a comment sheet on their performance.

St. Luke's Presbyterian Church is located inside Loop 610, off of South Braeswood, halfway between Buffalo Speedway and Stella Link. It is right across the street from Longfellow Elementary School. The Milligan Competition will take place inside the main building.
